Dear Mrs. Markle,

We are in receipt of your written request titled, "Formal Demand for Amendment of Report and Civilian Complaint Filing" received by this office via US Mail on April 3, 2025. It is apparent this document was intended to serve multiple purposes, one of which was to request reproduction of business records. The format of your request qualifies as a request pursuant to Government Code Section 6250, et. seq., commonly referred to as the California Public Records Act, and as such, this letter serves as a responsive document for that purpose. As the Custodian of Records for the California Highway Patrol (CHP), Barstow Area, I am duly authorized to produce and certify records in response to such requests.

In your letter, you requested, verbatim, the following:

"I hereby demand the production of all video footage, including from body cams, dash cams, or any on-scene surveillance. If this footage does not exist, I demand a written explanation of why not, given public funding and established policy."

The CHP Barstow Area has identified the following responsive record(s):

1. One digital versatile disc (DVD) containing patrol vehicle Mobile Video/Audio Recording System recording(s) pertaining to crash number 9835-2024-01013.

Pursuant to departmental policy, the DVD containing requested information will be mailed to you following payment of \$5.00 to this office. A CHP247 form has been prepared and enclosed with additional information. Acceptable payment types are check or money order. Alternatively, you may come to this office during normal business hours and view the contents of the DVD at no charge.

After a diligent search and reasonable inquiry, the CHP Barstow Area has determined there are no "body cam," "body-worn cameras," "any on-scene surveillance," or "black box (EDR)" records in the Department's possession. In response to your demand for explanation, no "footage" or "body cam" related recordings exist because the involved officer has not been issued one by the Department and did not possess or utilize a personally-owned body-worn camera.


